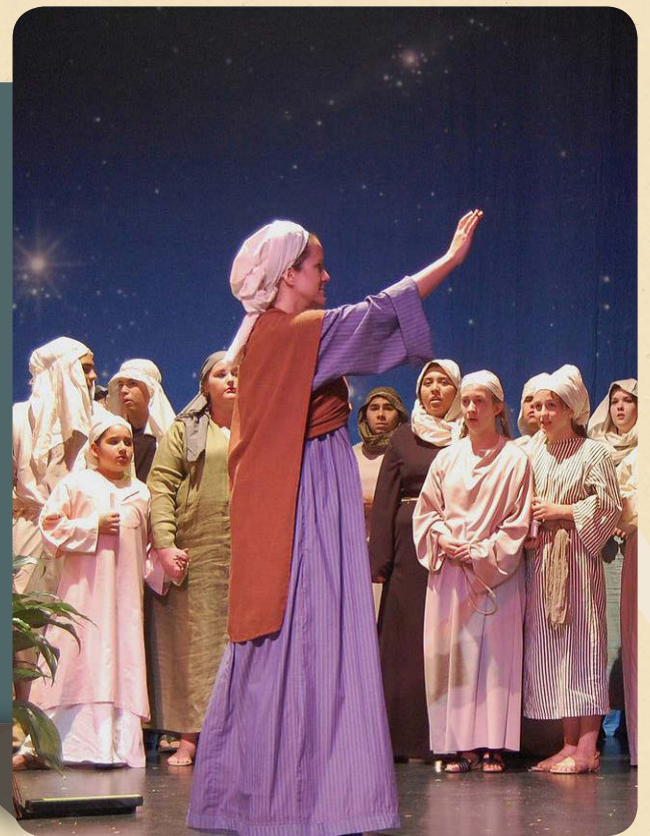

- Review Music Theory and Ear Training Exam Information
- Attend a Texas A&M University-Kingsville Music Department Audition Day
- Accept all Music Scholarship Offers by May 1st
