In Memoriam: Dr. Alberto Olivares

Dr. Alberto Olivares, former chemistry professor and Dean of the College of Graduate Studies and Director of the Office of Research, passed away September 29. He was 79. He served the university from 1971 to 2008. He started as an assistant professor of chemistry at Texas A&I University in 1971. In 1981, he was promoted to Dean of the College of Graduate Studies and Director of the Office of Research. He continued to teach chemistry and until he retired Aug. 29, 2008.

In 2011, the Texas A&M University System Board of Regents named him Professor Emeritus in chemistry. Olivares received the Distinguished Researcher award in 1980.
