



The Department of Music at Texas A&M University-Kingsville announces the 6<sup>th</sup> summer session of JUMP Camp to be held June 4-9, 2017. This is a wonderful grant-funded program for young women who are considering a career in music. It provides students with an opportunity to check out what majoring in music at a university would be like and it also allows them to live on that campus of TAMUK for a week to see if the school and its faculty are a good fit for them.

JUMP camp is designed for girls who are currently high school juniors (will be seniors graduating in May '18) and it is open to instrumentalists and vocalists.

**For a \$100 total cost** to the student, they receive:

- Daily Theory Class
- Daily Piano Class
- Daily Computer Class to reinforce music reading
- Daily Ensemble Class
- Daily Recitals by TAMUK Faculty and Students
- Daily lectures on music and college related topics such as audition technique, performance anxiety and life as a music major
- A lesson with teacher in the student's instrument/voice area
- Room and Board at the TAMUK dorms/cafeterias
- Evening social activities
- Ensemble performances on end of week recital
- End of week reception for campers' family and friends
- Camp T-shirt
- Piano Book

There is no cost to apply for the program. Once a student is accepted into the program, then she will need to mail in her check in order to reserve her spot.
