Additional learning outcomes. Participants will:

- * Discuss and develop EI project management for schools, colleges, universities, government, or business.
- * Discuss and develop a personal understanding of EI education and training strategies based on the participant's unique interests, contexts, needs, and work.
- * Demonstrate a working knowledge of both the transformational model of EI (Nelson & Low, 2003) and the Cognitive-Experiential Self-Theory (CEST) of personality (Epstein, 1997).
- * Identify and define at least three personally meaningful emotional skills.
- * Explain at least one EI-centric method for improving one's quality of life.
- * Develop and explain your own model of emotionally intelligent leadership and answer the question, "Does EI enhance or detract from strong leadership?"

Initial certification at the 2008 two-day workshop is \$300. In addition to the items noted above, tuition includes lunch both days, refreshments, personal working experience with the ESAP© and PEM© assessments, as well as workshop materials. Persons become eligible for project management accounts (for schools, college, universities, business, consulting, etc.) with EI Learning Systems, Inc., and certified to use the ESAP© and PEM© with their clients, organizations, and institutions.
