## Procedure Statement

---

Texas A&M University-Kingsville (TAMUK) protects data center information systems from damage resulting from water leakage by providing master shutoff or isolation valves that are accessible, working properly, and known to key personnel within the facilities department

## Reason for Procedure

---

This Control applies to all TAMUK network information resources. The intended audience for this Control includes all information resource owners, custodians, and users of information resources.

The university protects the information system from damage resulting from water leakage by providing master shutoff or isolation valves that are accessible, working properly, and known to key personnel.

---

## Procedures and Responsibilities

---

Information resource owners with responsibility over infrastructure equipment shall protect the information resource from damage resulting from water leakage by providing master shutoff or isolation valves that are accessible, working properly, and known to key personnel.
