## FALL 2015 GRADUATION PROFILE TEXAS A\&M UNIVERSITY-KINGSVILLE

* The FALL graduating class of 2015 at Texas A\&M University-Kingsville consisted of 874 graduates. Three of them received two bachelor's degrees. This makes a total of 877 degrees for Fall 2015. Out of 877 degrees granted, there are 299 bachelor's degrees, 567 master's degrees, and 11 doctoral degrees.
* Of the 874 graduates, $380(43 \%)$ were from Texas, 11 (1\%) were from other states or territories, including Connecticut (2), Florida (1), Guam (1), Kentucky (1), Michigan (1), Missouri (1), New Jersey (1), New York (1), North Dakota (1) and Ohio (1) when they first entered TAMUK. 483 (55\%) were from other countries or regions when they entered the university, including India (457), Nigeria (13), Canada (2), China (2), Mexico (2), Bangladesh (1), Ghana (1), Ivory Coast (1), Japan (1), Jordan (1), Pakistan (1) and United Arab Emirates (1).
* The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Hidalgo (75), followed by Cameron (49), Nueces (44), Kleberg (37) and Jim Wells (25).
* Of the graduating class, 296 (34\%) were minority students. 230 ( $78 \%$ ) of the bachelor's, 59 ( $10 \%$ ) of the master's and 7 ( $64 \%$ ) of the doctoral were minority students.
* Of the graduating class, 311 (36\%) were female. 156 (53\%) of the bachelor's, 148 (26\%) of the master's and 7 (64\%) of doctoral were female.
* Of the 296 undergraduates, 154 (52\%) entered the University as first-time undergraduates and 142 (48\%) entered as transfer students. Of the 154 first-time undergraduates, 61 (40\%) took at least one developmental course. Of the 142 transfer students, 5 (4\%) took at least one developmental course.
