## FALL 2016 GRADUATION PROFILE TEXAS A\&M UNIVERSITY - KINGSVILLE

* The FALL graduating class of 2016 at TAMUK consisted of 823 graduates. Two of them received two bachelor's degrees each. This makes a total of 825 degrees. Out of 825 degrees granted, there are 306 bachelor's degrees, 513 master's degrees, and 6 doctoral degrees.
* Of the 823 graduates, 420 ( $51 \%$ ) were from Texas and 12 (1.5\%) were from other states, including California (2), Iowa (2), Connecticut (1), Georgia (1), Maryland (1), Michigan (1), Mississippi (1), New York (1), Washington (1) and Wisconsin (1) when they first entered TAMUK. 391 (48\%) were from other countries or regions when they entered the university, including India (356), Nigeria (15), Ghana (4), China (3), Saudi Arabia (3), Mexico (2), Nepal (2), Argentina (1), Belize (1), Ivory Coast (1), Nicaragua (1), Niger (1) and Poland (1).
* The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Hidalgo (81), followed by Nueces (55), Kleberg (49), Cameron (42) and Jim Wells (24).
* Of the graduating class, 336 (41\%) were minority students. 239 (79\%) of the bachelor's, 94 (18\%) of the master's and 3 (50\%) of the doctoral degree recipients were minority students.
* Of the graduating class, 326 (40\%) were female. 170 (56\%) of the bachelor's, 151 (29\%) of the master's and 5 ( $83 \%$ ) of doctoral were female.
* Of the 304 undergraduates, 183 (60\%) entered the University as first-time freshmen and 121 (40\%) entered as transfer students. Of the 183 firsttime freshmen, 47 (26\%) took at least one developmental course. 7 (6\%) of the 121 transfer students took at least one developmental course.
