## FALL 2019 GRADUATION PROFILE TEXAS A\&M UNIVERSITY - KINGSVILLE

* The FALL graduating class of 2019 at TAMUK consisted of 525 graduates. Two of them received two bachelor's degrees each. This makes a total of 527 degrees. Out of 527 degrees granted, there are 354 bachelor's degrees, 164 master's degrees, and 9 doctoral degrees.
* Of the 525 graduates, 413 (79\%) were from Texas and 9 (2\%) were from other states, including California (3), Wisconsin (2), Georgia (1), Idaho (1), Indiana (1) and Oklahoma (1) when they first entered TAMUK. 103 (20\%) were from other countries or regions when they entered the university, including India (55), Nigeria (12), Kuwait (10), Saudi Arabia (6), Mexico (5), Niger (4), Bangladesh (2), China (2), Barbados (1), Cameroon (1), Colombia (1), Egypt (1), Germany (1), Iran (1), Laos (1) and Moldova (1).
* The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Hidalgo (57), followed by Nueces (51), Cameron (45), Kleberg (40) and Jim Wells (27).
* Of the graduating class, 330 (63\%) were minority students. 262 (74\%) of the bachelor's, 63 (38\%) of the master's and 5 (56\%) of the doctoral degree recipients were minority students.
* Of the graduating class, 257 (49\%) were female. 180 (51\%) of the bachelor's, 72 (44\%) of the master's and 5 ( $56 \%$ ) of doctoral were female.
* Of the 352 undergraduates, 200 (57\%) entered the University as first-time-in-college and 132 (38\%) entered as transfer students. Of the 200 first-time-in-college, 44 (22\%) took at least one developmental course. 3 (2\%) of the 132 transfer students took at least one developmental course.
* Of the 525 graduates, three were full-time university employees. All of them received a master's degree each.
