## SPRING 2016 GRADUATION PROFILE TEXAS A\&M UNIVERSITY-KINGSVILLE

* The SPRING graduating class of 2016 at Texas A\&M University-Kingsville consisted of 1015 graduates. Five of them received two bachelor's degrees. This makes a total of 1020 degrees for SPRING 2016. Out of 1020 degrees granted, there were 558 bachelor's degrees, 442 master's degrees, and 20 doctoral degrees.
* For Spring 2016, Texas A\&M University-Kingsville graduated the largest class ever in university history.
* Of the 1015 graduates, 638 ( $63 \%$ ) were from Texas, 17 ( $2 \%$ ) were from other states, including California (4), Florida (1), Kansas (1), Kentucky (1), Maryland (1), Nebraska (1), New Jersey (1), New York (1), North Dakota (1), Ohio (1), Oklahoma (1), Tennessee (1), Virginia (1) and Washington (1) when they first entered TAMUK. 360 (35\%) were from other countries or regions when they entered the university, including India (328), Nigeria (9), Saudi Arabia (6), Mexico (4), China (3), Bangladesh (2), Taiwan (2), Iran (1), Ivory Coast (1), Kuwait (1), Poland (1), Syrian Arab Republic (1) and United Arab Emirates (1).
* The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Hidalgo (108), followed by Nueces (81), Cameron (70), Kleberg (66) and Bexar (38).
* Of the graduating class, 515 (51\%) were minority students. 435 ( $79 \%$ ) of the bachelor's, 67 (15\%) of the master's and 13 (65\%) of doctoral graduates were minority students.
* Of the graduating class, 415 (41\%) were female. 286 (52\%) of the bachelor's, 115 (26\%) of the master's and 14 (70\%) of doctoral were female.
* Of the 553 undergraduates, 296 (54\%) entered the University as first-time undergraduates and 257 (46\%) entered as transfer students. Of the 296 first-time undergraduates, 90 (30\%) took at least one developmental course. Of the 257 transfer students, 5 (2\%) took at least one developmental course.
