## SPRING 2023 GRADUATION PROFILE TEXAS A\&M UNIVERSITY-KINGSVILLE

* The SPRING graduating class of 2023 at Texas A\&M University-Kingsville consisted of 735 graduates. Six of them received two bachelor's degrees each. This makes a total of 741 degrees for SPRING 2023. Out of 741 degrees granted, there were 495 (67\%) bachelor's degrees, 240 (32\%) master's degrees, and 6 (1\%) doctoral degrees.
* Of the 735 graduates, 580 (79\%) were from Texas, 21 (3\%) were from other states or United States Armed Forces when they entered the university, including Alabama (2), California (2), Colorado (2), Florida (2), Nevada (2), Oklahoma (2), Indiana (1), Kansas (1), Minnesota (1), Montana (1), North Carolina (1), Ohio (1), Tennessee (1), Virginia (1), and Washington (1). 134 (18\%) were from other countries or regions, including India (96), Kuwait (9), Nigeria (9), Mexico (4), Nepal (2), Saudi Arabia (2), Vietnam (2), Bangladesh (1), Belgium (1), China (1), Cyprus (1), Egypt (1), Ghana (1), Jamaica (1), Jordan (1), Pakistan (1) and Qatar (1).
* The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Nueces (106), followed by Hidalgo (67), Cameron (60), Kleberg (49) and Jim Wells (41).
* Of the graduating class, 478 ( $65 \%$ ) were minority students. 385 ( $79 \%$ ) of the bachelor's, $91(38 \%)$ of the master's, and $2(33 \%)$ of the doctoral graduates were minority students.
* Of the graduating class, 348 (47\%) were female. 225 (46\%) of the bachelor's, 120 (50\%) of the master's, and 3 (50\%) of the doctoral graduates were female.
* Of the 489 undergraduates, 301 (62\%) entered the university as first-time undergraduates and 188 (38\%) entered as transfer students. Of the 301 first-time undergraduates, 59 (20\%) took at least one developmental course. Of the 188 transfer students, 3 (2\%) took at least one developmental course.
* Of the 735 graduates, five were full-time university employees, including three receiving bachelor's degrees and the other two who earned master's degrees.
