## SUMMER 2016 GRADUATION PROFILE TEXAS A\&M UNIVERSITY - KINGSVILLE

* The SUMMER graduating class of 2016 at TAMUK consisted of 357 graduates. One of them received two bachelor's degrees. This makes a total of 358 degrees. Out of 358 degrees granted, there are 132 bachelor's degrees, 219 master's degrees, and 7 doctoral degrees.
* Of the 357 graduates, 219 ( $61 \%$ ) were from Texas and 17 (5\%) were from other states, including New York (3), Virginia (2), Georgia (1), Illinois (1), Indiana (1), Louisiana (1), Maryland (1), Massachusetts (1), Michigan (1), North Carolina (1), Oklahoma (1), Pennsylvania (1), Utah (1) and Washington (1) when they first entered TAMUK. 121 (34\%) were from other countries or regions when they entered the university, including India (105), Bangladesh (4), Mexico (2), Nigeria (2), Bulgaria (1), China (1), Iran (1), Kuwait (1), Nepal (1), Norway (1), Russia (1) and Saudi Arabia (1).
* The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Nueces (39), followed by Hidalgo (36), Kleberg (28), Cameron (15) and San Patricio (12).
* Of the graduating class, 165 (46\%) were minority students. 96 (73\%) of the bachelor's, 64 (29\%) of the master's and 5 (71\%) of the doctoral degree recipients were minority students.
* Of the graduating class, 143 (40\%) were female. 55 (42\%) of the bachelor's, $81(37 \%)$ of the master's and $7(100 \%)$ of doctoral were female.
* Of the 131 undergraduates, 66 (50\%) entered the University as first-time freshmen and 65 (50\%) entered as transfer students. Of the 66 first-time freshmen, 28 ( $42 \%$ ) took at least one developmental course. None of the 65 transfer students took any developmental course.
