The following documents must be submitted by the appropriate application deadline:

- 1) Completed Application
- 2) Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended showing final degree conferred.
- 3) Official scores on the Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT)
- 4) Official scores on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) exam *International Students Only*

Admission Requirements

A student must be admitted to the College of Graduate Studies and to a specific program in order to take graduate level courses. The MBA Admissions Committee prefers applicants to have a minimum undergraduate cumulative GPA of 2.6 or higher. Applicants, who meet or exceed the preferred GPA requirement, will be eligible for a one semester waiver of the GMAT exam. A satisfactory GMAT score must be submitted before continuing in the program. Applicants, who do not meet the preferred GPA requirement, must submit a satisfactory GMAT score prior to admission.

GMAT Requirement

The MBA Admissions Committee uses the following formula to determine an applicant's minimum GMAT score requirement (**GPA X 200**) + **GMAT Score = 970**). Applicants, who have earned a graduate degree from a regionally accredited institution, will receive a waiver of the GMAT requirement.



Course Schedules

The majority of the courses are offered Monday thru Thursday in the evening. The courses are taught in two different formats: Hybrid and Online. Hybrid courses blend traditional classroom instruction with online learning. Hybrid courses meet in the classroom once a week for an hour and twenty minutes, which is followed by asynchronous class time for the remainder of the week. The On-line courses generally meet for an orientation session and proctored exams.

MBA Stem Courses (prerequisite) Requirements

Students who do not have an undergraduate degree in Business, are required to successfully complete 12 semester credit hours of graduate level stem courses before taking the MBA required courses listed below. The MBA Stem courses are on-line self paced courses. For more information regarding these courses, please speak with the Graduate Advisor in the College of Business.
