- your 10-character placement cohort code
- your 20-character ALEKS access code
- your K# (student ID)

To enroll in your placement cohort, log in at www.aleks.com and click on the “SIGN UP NOW!” link.

Enter the 10-character course code for your placement cohort that was emailed to you in the space provided. Then click on the “>> Continue” button.

After entering a valid course code, verify the placement cohort information, then click on the “>> Continue” link.





Second Option: I Have an ALEKS Login Name

If the student already has an existing ALEKS account, selecting the “I have an ALEKS login name” option will expand the box and allow the student to enter her ALEKS login name and password. Then, the student clicks on the “>> Continue” button.
