SCHOLARSHIPS

Transfer Excellence Scholarship

- Merit-based scholarships are awarded to new transfer students with outstanding academic qualifications (transfer GPA of 3.0 or higher).
- Scholarships are awarded based on information from the admission application.
- No separate application is required.
- Awards are available for up to two years if students meet eligibility criteria.

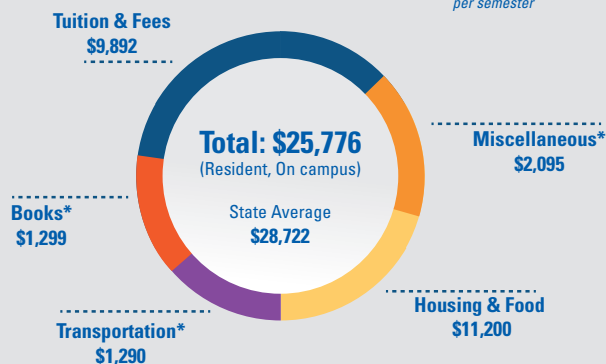
