

POST-TENURE REVIEW SCHEDULE

SPRING 2013

January 11	Chair or library director should notify departmental faculty members who are to be considered for post-tenure review to begin preparing their files.
March 4	Faculty members considered for post-tenure review forward completed files to department chair or library director.
March 25	Initial assessment phase completed and written narrative given to faculty member.
April 1	Faculty member and department chair or library director set long-range goals.
April 8	The Triad Peer Review Committee is formed and reviews the narrative and long-range goals developed by the faculty member and chair or library director. The Triad Committee provides comments to the chair or library director.
April 26	If necessary, Development Plan is written by faculty member and department chair or library director.
April 29	Report and Development Plan forwarded to college dean or AVP for Academic Affairs.
May 3	Report and Development Plan forwarded to provost.
