The Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Research Center and the **Citrus Center**, located in Weslaco, garner international recognition.

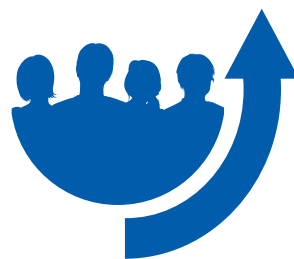
The National Natural Toxins Research Center is the only federally funded viper research center in the United States and is one of the leading research centers in the world for discovering toxins for use in biomedical research.

UNIVERSITY NAMED FASTEST GROWING SCHOOL IN THE NATION

The Chronicle of Higher Education recognized Texas A&M-Kingsville as the fastest-growing public doctoral institution in the country in its Almanac of Higher Education 2015 this summer. The publication tracked enrollment from 2003 to 2013 to determine its rankings, and A&M-Kingsville rose to the top for that period. In the last five years alone, enrollment has climbed 54 percent. About 35 tenure-track faculty positions have been added to address the growth, and Fall 2015 enrollment is on track to surpass 9,000 students.

In order for an application to be complete and receive full consideration, all International applicants must submit the following:

UNDERGRADUATE

- 1) Apply Texas application
<https://www.applytexas.org>
- 2) Nonrefundable application fee of \$50.00 (U.S. dollars on U.S. banks)
- 3) Official secondary school transcripts
- 4) Official transcripts with subjects and marks received from any colleges or universities attended
- 5) Certified, literal translations of all credentials officially issued in any language other than English
- 6) TOEFL score of 61 (IBT) or 500 (PBT). A score of 79/550 is required for College of Arts and Sciences and the Frank H. Dotterweich College of Engineering.
- 7) Financial documents for I-20 issuance visit www.tamuk.edu/iss
- 8) (Transfer) International Student Status Transfer Form completed by student and DSO of current institution, copy of current I-20; copy of student's F1 visa; Copy of I-95 (front & back)

- 2) Nonrefundable application fee of \$50.00 (U.S. dollars on U.S. banks)
- 3) Official transcripts with certified English translation
- 4) TOEFL score of 79 or higher (IBT) or 550 (PBT), or IELTS score of 6.0 or higher
- 5) GRE/GMAT/MAT scores (Depends on the program of interest)
- 6) Personal Statement, Resume, and 3 Letters of Recommendation
- 7) Copy of passport
