<p>T- Over forecushion Beneath buttface Alongside buttface Seamfat Ham collar</p> <p>M- Buttface -GAEL -Deeper -Wider Center section -Longer -Deeper -Wider Cushion -Plumper -More muscular -Deeper Heel Shank Forecushion -Fuller</p> <p>Q- Marbling -intramuscular Color -Pinkish Red -Darker/lighter -2-toned Texture -Softer/Firmer Exudative -purge beneath the ham (PSE = Pale, Soft, and Exudative = not good)</p>	Contestant No.

	1 <sup>st</sup>	4	2 <sup>nd</sup>	1
	3 <sup>rd</sup>	2	4 <sup>th</sup>	3
	1	<p>-2<sup>nd</sup> heaviest muscled, 2<sup>nd</sup> deepest buttface and center section, 2<sup>nd</sup> deepest cushion</p> <p>-one of three trim hams—yet not the trimmest</p> <p>-Most marbling in buttface, most 2-toned color in the buttface</p>		
	2	<p>-trimmest ham</p> <p>-Widest yet shallow buttface, shallowest center section, least muscular cushion</p> <p>-Most pinkish red color buttface, least amount of marbling, most exudative, softest lean in the buttface</p>		
	3	<p>-Fattest ham</p> <p>-Narrowest buttface, one of two shallow buttfaced hams, narrowest center section, shortest shank</p> <p>-2<sup>nd</sup> best color of lean in the buttface.</p>		
	4	<p>-Heaviest muscled, GAEL in buttface, deepest center section, deepest cushion, fullest forecushion</p> <p>--one of three trim hams—yet of the three had the most fat over forecushion and ham collar</p> <p>-palest colored buttface yet still good color.</p>
