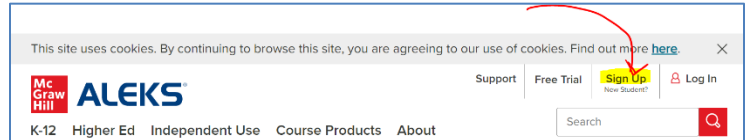


Student Registration Instructions

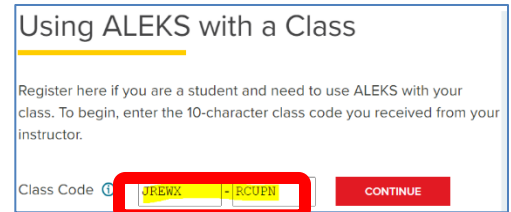
Before you begin, you will need a **10-character Class Code** provided by your instructor.
 For assistance during registration, please contact ALEKS Customer Support at <http://support.aleks.com>.

Step 1: Go to www.aleks.com and click on **SIGN UP!**

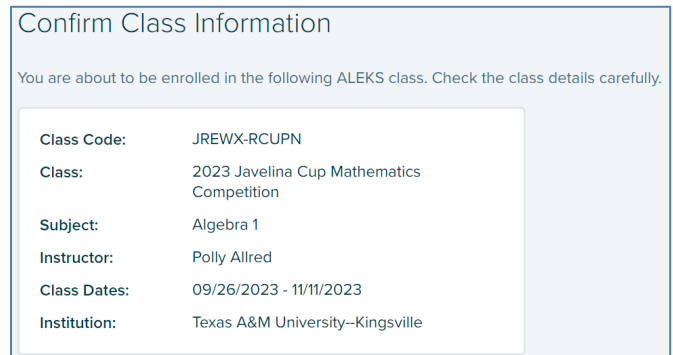


Step 2: Enter the following course code: **JREW - RCUPN**

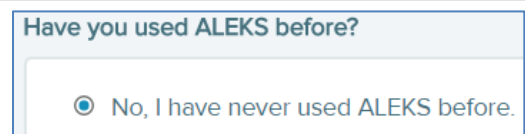
Click **Continue**.



Step 3: Verify your enrollment information. If your information is correct, click on **Confirm** at the bottom of the screen. If it is incorrect, check your class code and click on **Cancel** in order to start at Step 1 again.



Step 4: Choose "No, I have never used ALEKS before" and click **Continue** at the bottom of the screen.

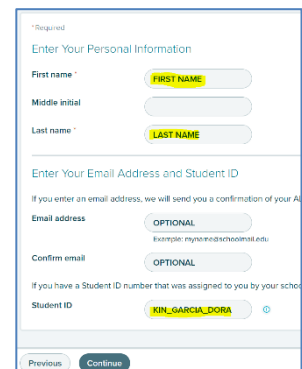


Step 5: Enter your personal information. First and last name are required. E-mail address is not required, but messages from the instructor can be forwarded to an e-mail address that is entered.

Student ID is required. **Use the following format for student ID:**

- First 3 letters (all caps) of school/ISD _ teacher last name _ teacher first name
- Example: If ISD = Kingsville, and teacher = Dora Garcia, then format is KIN_Garcia_Dora.

Once the information has been entered, click on Continue.



Step 6: You will be given a Login Name and Password. You have the option to keep the automatically-generated password or change it to one of your choice.

Write your Login Name and password down.

Click on **Continue** to complete your registration.

Step 6: You have finished registering for the class.

To be enrolled in the class, Texas A&M University needs to authorize you. Once you are authorized (allow 2-3 business days), log in to your ALEKS account and click on the tile that says "**2023 Javelina Cup Mathematics Competition-Fall 2023**" to begin!

You will complete an Initial Knowledge Check at first. This is a diagnostic assessment that will set up your 'PIE' which has topics you need to learn and practice. When preparing for this competition, do not use any external websites or handheld calculators, because they will not be allowed during the competition.
