8 Tips for Great Writing

It is all about timing, planning, and revising.



1. Start as early as you can. As Soon As you can receive the assignment, start planning for it- especially #2...
2. Try to understand the situation that you are writing for as well as you can. Find out as much as you can about the purpose, audience, and style of writing.



3. Make sure your assignment has your name, date, professor's name, and a title.
4. Be sure there is some sort of introduction that makes it clear to readers what you are writing about and why you are writing it, provides smooth transitions between paragraphs or subsections, and offers a conclusion that fits the assignment.
5. If there are references, make sure they are in an appropriate format style.
6. Give yourself plenty of time to reread and revise your writing as many times as it takes.
7. Be sure to proofread your writing carefully.
