DEGREE PLAN NOTES:

"C" or better Courses: ENGL 1301, ENGL 1302, MATH 1314, ACCT 2301, ACCT 2302, ECON 2301, ECON 2302, & ISYS 3330. 1)

ENGL 1301 & 1302 must be completed within the first 75 hours of course work. A total of 9 hours of English is required. 2)

- COMS 1311 may not be substituted for COMS 1315. 3)
- Students who choose to take ENLG 2314 must fulfill the general education ^Lang/Phil/Culture requirement by taking an appropriate course as one of the nonbusiness electives. 4)

Students who transfer into the College of Business with 20 or more hours may substitute two one-hour courses for UNIV 1101 and UNIV 1102. 5)

- Nonbusiness courses must be 3 credit hours. It is recommended these courses are 1000 2000 level. 6)
- 7) BCOM 3306 is a writing intensive course and must be a "C" or better.
- Advanced Electives must be 3000-4000 level courses. 8)

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

- All SPDP workshops must be completed by the end of your sophomore year & Immersion Experience completed before graduation. 1)
- Overall GPA of 2.0 in each of the following four categories: 1) All TAMU-K courses 2) Both TAMU-K & Transfer work 3) All courses in Major 4) All Business Courses 2)
- Twenty-five percent of the total hours required must have been taken at TAMU-K. (30 hrs for a BBA) Also, 24 of the last 30 hours must be taken at TAMU-K. 3)
- A minimum of 36 hours of upper-division course work is required. 4)
