## DEGREE PLAN NOTES:

"C" or better Courses: ENGL 1301, ENGL 1302, MATH 1314, ACCT 2301, ACCT 2302, ECON 2301, ECON 2302, & ISYS 2302. 1)

ENGL 1301 & 1302 must be completed within the first 75 hours of course work. A total of 9 hours of English is required. 2)

- MATH 1324, 1334 or any course for which one of these courses is a prerequisite also fulfills University requirement of MATH 1314. 3)
- Students who choose to take ENLG 2314 must fulfill the general education ^Lang/Phil/Culture requirement by taking an appropriate course as one of the nonbusiness electives. 4)
- Students who transfer into the College of Business with 20 or more hours may substitute two one-hour courses for UNIV 1101 and UNIV 1102. 5)
- Nonbusiness courses must be 3 credit hours. It is recommended these courses are 1000 2000 level. 6)
- 7) Students who choose to take ENGL 2314 must fulfill the core curriculum ^Lang/Phil/Culture.
- 8) BCOM 3306 is a writing intensive course  $% \mathcal{C}^{(2)}$  and must be a  $^{\prime\prime}\mathcal{C}^{\prime\prime}$  or better.
- Advanced Electives must be 3000-4000 level courses. MGMT 4390 Must be taken final semester before graduation. 9)
- 10) Accounting majors cannot choose ACCT 3305 Federal Income Tax as an ADV ACCT Elective course.

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

- All SPDP workshops must be completed by the end of your sophomore year & Immersion Experience completed before graduation 1)
- 2) Overall GPA of 2.0 in each of the following four categories: 1) All TAMU-K courses 2) Both TAMU-K & Transfer work 3) All courses in Major 4) All Business Courses
- 3) Twenty-five percent of the total hours required must have been taken at TAMU-K. (24 hrs of the last 30 hrs must be taken at TAMU-K)
- 4) A minimum of 36 hours of upper-division course work is required.
