Originally from Kingsville, Emmie Purdy graduated from Santa Gertrudis Academy High School as the valedictorian of the Class of 2023 and chose to continue her education close to home here at Texas A&M University-Kingsville. Today, she is graduating summa cum laude with a Bachelor of Science degree in Biomedical Sciences with a minor in Chemistry.

Throughout her time at TAMUK, Purdy was recognized for her academic excellence as a recipient of the John Talmer Peacock Scholarship, the Carl E. and Judy Kreuz Wood Scholarship, the Presidential Scholarship, and the Pre-Medical Association Academic Excellence Award. She also earned a place on the President's List every semester. And the awards haven't stopped. Purdy has been chosen the Distinguished Student for the College of Arts and Sciences.

Purdy served as the Public Relations Officer for the Pre-Medical Association, helping organize events and recruit students interested in healthcare careers. She also worked as a chemistry tutor at the Pathways Academic Assistance Center (PAAC), completing over 450 hours of tutoring in subjects such as Inorganic Chemistry and Biology.

Purdy plans to continue her education and pursue a career in the medical field, with the goal of serving rural and medically underserved communities in South Texas.

Harley Davis, a first-generation college student, was born in Meridian, Mississippi and moved to Yorktown, Texas at age 13. He is a 2022 graduate of Yorktown High School, where he finished in the top 10% of his class. Today, Davis graduates Magna Cum Laude with a Bachelor of Science in Kinesiology, with a concentration in Sport and Leisure Studies and a minor in Psychology, completing his degree in just three years.

During his time at Texas A&M-Kingsville, Davis has been a dynamic campus leader. He is currently completing his second term as Student Body President, representing thousands of students and leading a 42-member governing body. As President of the Chancellor's Student Advisory Council, he advocates for student voices across the Texas A&M University System. He has also served as Freshman Class Senator and Treasurer in Student Government, earning the Outstanding Freshman Senator Award.

Davis has been deeply involved in campus life. He is a founding Father and former Vice President of Finance for Alpha Sigma Phi Fraternity. He is also a member of Order of Omega Greek Honor Society; Phi Epsilon Kappa Kinesiology Honor Society, Heath and Kinesiology Club, and the Campus Activities Board, where he served as secretary and won the CAB General Member of the Year in 2023. He also served as Pack Leader and Executive Director for Javelina Freshman Camp, mentoring and welcoming incoming students. Davis was also elected Homecoming King in Fall 2023, reflecting the respect and admiration of he peers.

Davis' dedication to leadership, academics and student success has been recognized through multiple scholarships and awards, including the Academic Excellence, Hugh Porter Mathematics, Bill and Judy Colston, Fred and Peggy Steves Education Scholarship Endowment, and Texas A&I Alumni Scholarships.

He plans to continue his education with a Master of Science in Kinesiology with a concentration in Sports Management and pursue the Texas A&M System Student Regent position, a one-year appointment by the Governor of Texas.


ACADEMIC REGALIA

The origin of academic gowns, caps and hoods is a matter of speculation. Unheated buildings may have necessitated the gowns. The remaining regalia might reflect the influence of the clergy during medieval times. The hoods, for example, might have served as head-coverings before skull caps were adopted. In any case, when American schools decided to adopt academic dress, they agreed, through a series of meetings and conferences, on some standard designs and colors. The gown design becomes more intricate with advanced degrees. Velvet trim, for instance, is reserved for doctors' gowns. The hoods, too, become longer as one proceeds from the bachelor's to the master's to the doctor's degree. The cap is plain for both bachelor's and master's. Velvet is reserved for the doctorate. The tassel on the cap may be black or the color appropriate for the major field of study. A doctor's tassel, however, may be made of gold thread.

The color of the facing of the hood denotes the type of degree, and doctors' gowns may also be trimmed in the same color. Examples are as follows: Arts and Letters - white, Commerce and Accounting - drab, Economics - copper, Library Science - lemon, Music - pink, Education - light blue, Pharmacy - olive, Fine Arts and Architecture - brown, Humanities - dark crimson, Law - purple, Engineering - orange, Philosophy - dark blue, Physical Education - sage green, Science - golden yellow. The color of the lining of the hood denotes the university or college granting the degree. Texas A&M University-Kingsville's colors are blue and gold. Students wearing the blue and green or gold honor cords are members of national honor societies. Official honors designation, which includes the calculation of the current semester's grades, will be indicated on the final transcript and diploma.

THE TOWER CHIMES

Striking on the hour and every quarter hour, the "Westminster" chimes of the College Hall tower were played for the first time in March 1999 for the inauguration of President Marc Cisneros. The chimes celebrate Javelina pride throughout the day, ringing out "Hail AMK" and "Jalisco."



THE UNIVERSITY BANNERS

Eight banners signify the university and its academic areas: Agriculture and Natural Resources; Arts and Sciences; Business Administration; Education and Human Performance; Engineering; Graduate Studies and Honors College. One banner represents the Student Government Association. Each banner displays the university logo, which includes the College Hall tower and the university name. The tower has stood as a symbol of the institution since 1949, reflecting the iconic architectural elements of the campus that draw upon the university's regional heritage. The blue and gold banners are five feet by three feet, trimmed with fringe at the bottom.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

A representation of authority, the mace is traced to an ancient weapon of war. William the Conqueror is seen flourishing a wooden mace in the eleventh-century Bayeux Tapestry. The military use of the object gradually gave way to its ceremonial function, and maces became jewel-encrusted symbols of high office. A newly crafted mace made from hand-crafted walnut featuring brass accents and topped with a replica of the University Seal debuted during the Fall 2023 commencement ceremonies. The presiding officer of the Faculty Advisory Council leads the University's esteemed faculty and staff during each commencement ceremony processional, carrying the mace as a symbol of academic excellence and integrity.

THE UNIVERSITY RING

In early 1998, a committee of students, alumni, faculty and staff began discussing the idea of an official ring for graduates of the university. The committee members wanted the ring to reflect symbols that represented the university's history and traditions. Working with a professional designer, they chose symbols including the school's mascot, the javelina, because of its tenacity; mesquite and cactus because they are found all over campus; the Lone Star because it symbolizes the State of Texas; and the College Hall tower because it is a recognized landmark on our campus. Graduates can choose a plain gold ring or opt for a gemstone in the ring. The ring design was unveiled February 16, 1999.
