

# 2022 COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

In accordance with guidance from the Texas A&M University System and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Texas A&M-Kingsville has revised COVID-19 quarantine/isolation protocol as follows:



1

Employees and students who have tested positive for COVID-19 can elect to:

## STAY HOME 5 DAYS

- If **asymptomatic** or if symptoms are resolving, you may re-test on-campus with a rapid COVID-19 test on the 6th day.
- If **negative**, you may return to campus wearing a well-fitting mask for an additional 5 days.



## OR FULL QUARANTINE

- Stay home for a full 10-day quarantine after administration of a positive test.

Individuals who are unvaccinated or are more than six months out from their 2nd mRNA vaccine dose and have not received a booster and have been exposed to COVID-19 can:

## STAY HOME 5 DAYS

- Stay home for five days after exposure and return to work on the 6th day **IF** you wear a mask to work/campus for an additional five days



## OR FULL QUARANTINE

- Stay home for 10 days after last exposure.

Individuals who have received a booster shot or completed second mRNA dose within the last six months and have been exposed to COVID-19, can choose to:

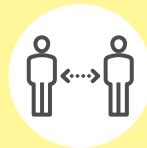
## WEAR MASK FOR 10 DAYS

- Wear a mask to work/campus for 10 days after last exposure



## OR FULL QUARANTINE

- Stay home for 10 days after last exposure.



## CLOSE-CONTACT EXPOSURE

Contact with a COVID-19 positive individual, who was less than 6 ft away for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more in a 24-hour period.

## RAPID TESTING FOR COVID-19 POSITIVE INDIVIDUALS

On-campus rapid testing will be available for COVID-19 positive individuals seeking to return to campus after 5 days of quarantine at:
