2022 COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

In accordance with guidance from the Texas A&M University System and the **Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Texas** A&M-Kingsville has revised COVID-19 guarantine/isolation protocol as follows:



Employees and students who have tested positive for COVID-19 can elect to:

STAY HOME 5 DAYS

- If asymptomatic or if symptoms are resolving, you may re-test on-campus with a rapid COVID-19 test on the 6th day.
- \+{(
- If negative, you may return to campus wearing a well-fitting mask for an additional 5 days.

OR FULL QUARANTINE

• Stay home for a full 10-day guarantine after administration of a positive test.



Individuals who are unvaccinated or are more than six months out from their 2nd mRNA vaccine dose and have not received a booster and have been exposed to COVID-19 can:

STAY HOME 5 DAYS

• Stay home for five days after exposure and return to work on the 6th day IF you wear a mask to work/campus for an additional five davs

OR FULL QUARANTINE

• Stay home for 10 days after last exposure.



Individuals who have received a booster shot or completed second mRNA dose within the last six months and have been exposed to COVID-19, can choose to:

WEAR MASK FOR **10 DAYS**

- Wear a mask to work/ campus for 10 days after last exposure

OR FULL QUARANTINE

• Stay home for 10 days after last exposure.



CLOSE-CONTACT EXPOSURE

Contact with a COVID-19 positive individual, who was less than 6 ft away for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more in a 24-hour period.
