The chapter must develop and implement an approved recruitment plan and have that on file with the University. That plan must focus on anti-hazing, alcohol abuse and illegal drug awareness. 2.) New members must also participate in hazing prevention during their first week of their new member process. 3.) All chapter members must participate in anti-hazing programs during the fall and spring semesters. 4.) The executive Board and Pledge Educator must complete a minimum of three hours of anti-hazing prevention education prior to the start of the recruitment period. 5.) Kappa Sigma Theta-Kappa will play an active role in Hazing Prevention week on the campus. The chapter will complete 2 approved community service projects. 6.) The Grand Master will meet weekly with the Director of Student Activities. While not noted in the sanction guidelines given to the chapter, the Assistant Vice President of Student Affairs/Dean of Students will attend some of these weekly meetings. 7.) The Executive Board of the chapter will meet weekly with the Director of Student Activities. While not noted in the sanction guidelines given to the chapter, the Assistant Vice President of Student Affairs/Dean of Students will attend some of these monthly meetings.
