2. ENGL 1301 & 1302; HIST 1301 & 1302; MATH 1314 or higher. **\*ENGL 1302 must be a “C” or better.**
3. Official degree plan on file.
4. Cumulative GPA of 2.05 or better (includes all transfer work).
5. Must qualify for college level course enrollment based on placement scores in Reading, Writing and Mathematics.
6. Pass Nelson Denny Reading Test
7. Criminal History Disclosure & Consent Forms **must be signed.**
8. Grade of “C” or better in all courses with “ED...” prefix.
