

Pre-Admission Content Testing (PACT)

You are eligible to take a TExES exam via the Pre-Admission Content Testing (PACT) route if:

- You hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited university
- You are seeking certification as a classroom teacher
- You have not been enrolled or accepted into an educator preparation program

***All candidates are required to submit a passing TExES exam score as a basis of admission to the ACP.**

To register for the exam:

2. Click Register
3. Complete information
4. Select "No TEA ID"
5. Complete profile
6. Select "Pre-Admission Content Test" for Testing Route and complete required information.
7. Proceed to review and test registration

Please note: PACT is simply the route that allows you to take examinations without being affiliated with a particular education program. The test for which you register is not called PACT, it is called TExES. A passing score on the PACT does not guarantee admittance to the program. Scores must be sent by the applicant to the ACP office as we do not receive them from the testing company.
