EDLD Doctoral Program Cognate Areas

Cognates

The cognate is 18 credit hours of specialization in a selected field. Candidates may choose a cognate in an area that supports their professional goals. The most common cognate areas are Higher Education Administration and Leadership and Superintendency; however, any area in which there is a graduate degree is eligible for use as a cognate area, including Adult Education, Early Childhood, Educational Administration (Principal Certificate), Instructional Technology, Reading, Special Education, or content areas (math, English, biology, etc.).

Credit for Cognate Area

Courses for credit toward the 18-hour cognate area for the program must *not* have been credited toward any other graduate-level degree. In addition, course work for the cognate must be current and shall *not be older than ten* (10) years at the date of graduation. A maximum of 15 hours may be transferred in from another accredited institution and counted toward the cognate area component of the program. Additionally, all transfer courses must be 5000 or 6000- level courses and must be approved by the program coordinator. Only courses with grades of B (3.0) or higher are considered for transfer.
