Application, Scholarship Acceptance Disclosures

College of Education and Human Performance under the Texas A&M University-Kingsville (TAMUK) expressly discloses the following: (*Please initial each box*)

1.	As a provider of educator preparation programs, TAMU-K must ensure teacher candidates adhere to the Code of Ethics and Standard Practices for Texas Educators, which requires federal and state law observance. An arrest, indictment, conviction, and deferred adjudication may result in a teacher candidate's dismissal from the educator preparation program and the possibility of receiving the EPP Scholarship. When applying for state certification, teacher candidates are again subject to a criminal history background and fingerprint check by the State Board for Educator Certification. A certificate applicant with a criminal history may be denied certification and any EPP scholarship opportunity through the College of Education & Human Performance at TAMU-K.			
2.	Texas public schools are required by state law to conduct criminal history background checks on people intended for hire or who have requested a volunteer position. Teacher candidates participating in field experiences or clinical teaching in a Texas public school may also be subject to a criminal history background check.			
3.	EPP Scholarship awards for the TAMU-K Educator Preparation Program do not guarantee that the teacher candidate will be accepted into a field experience or clinical teaching placement or granted a teaching certificate. The student must continue to be actively enrolled in TAMU-K in the EPP program. Failure to comply with these terms will result in the termination of the scholarship and any future disbursements/awards.			
4.	All TAMUK scholarships are awarded under federal, state, and institutional rules and regulations.
