| SMME Environmental Scholarship \$500 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Freshmen and transfers must have a 2.5 GPA Continuing undergraduate and graduate students must have a 3.0 minimum GPA. |
| Transfer Excellence Scholarship Varies \$1,000 - \$2,000 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eligible for new transfer students Transfer students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 |
| Javelina Promise Tuition and fees fully covered for up to 4 years. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eligible for first-time in college, transfers, and continuing undergraduate students For details on eligibility requirements, check this link: https://www.tamuk.edu/javelinapromise |
| Enbridge Environmental Engineering Scholarship Varies \$500 - \$1,000 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eligible for freshmen, transfers, and continuing undergraduate and graduate students Incoming freshmen must have a 21 ACT and/or 970 SAT Freshmen and transfers must have a 3.0 GPA Continuing undergraduate students must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA, and 30 completed semester credit hours |
| Herbst Family Environmental Engineering Scholarship Varies \$500 - \$1,000 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continuing graduate students must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA, and 9 completed semester credit hours Continuing undergraduate/graduate students should be working in a research project related to the environmental sustainability relevant to the Coastal Bend area (Enbridge Scholarship) or relevant to the South Texas region (Herbst Family Scholarship). |
