HIGHLIGHTS

- ▲ Nine-week summer undergraduate research program.
- ▲ \$4,050 stipends plus additional travel allowance (round-trip to Kingsville and potential conference after the summer program).
- ▲ Meal allowance stipend (\$105/week) and Free on-campus housing provided.
- ▲ Multidisciplinary research teams with extension experiences, research, educational, and career mentorship.
- ▲ Weekly seminars/webinars about various research disciplines, field trips, technical writing, presentation skills, graduate school preparation, etc.

ELIGIBILITY

Students must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents, and must be enrolled in a degree program in community college or four-year university when participating the program. Students must have 3.0 or above GPA
