*Students studying Spanish are placed in one or two tracks by examination, heritage and nonheritage. The course sequence for nonheritage track students is SPAN 1313, SPAN 1314, SPAN 2311, and SPAN 2312. The course sequence for heritage-track students is SPAN 1373, SPAN 2301, SPAN 2302, plus one advanced Spanish (junior or senior level) of the student's choice. In addition, students are required to complete their foreign language requirements in a single language track.

**Two hours for UNIV will be made up from the labs of MATH 1414, SPAN 1411 and/or SPAN 1412 if these courses are taken. If not, student will be responsible for two additional hours.

****POLS, US, adv. students may choose from POLS 4313 (The President & Congress [WI]), 4317 (Nuclr Prolf and Non Prolf Pol), 4331 (Constitutional Law I), 4332 (Constitutional Law II), 4333 (American Justice Process), 4334, or 4363 (Policy and Policy Making in US). Social Science, adv. students may choose from ANTH 3301 (American Cultures Before 1492), 3302 (Prin of Cultural Anthropol), GEOG 3310 (World in Chg Crucial Topics), 3331 (United States and Canada), PSYC 3301 (Social Psychology), 3313 (Psychology of Women [WI]), or SOCI 4307 (The Family and Marriage), 4362 (Race Relations), 4364 (Minority Women in US Society).

Although following a pathway does not guarantee admission to Texas A&M-Kingsville, it gives you a clear roadmap to prepare for your major and be well positioned to graduate on time.

Candidates for a bachelor's degree must have a minimum of 25% of total semester credit hours (SCH) required for the degree completed in residence at Texas A&M-Kingsville. Twenty-four of the last 30 SCH must be taken at Texas A&M-Kingsville.

A major when specified as a degree requirement shall consist of a minimum of 24 SCH in one subject, 6 of which must be taken at Texas A&M-Kingsville. In English, the required freshman courses may not count as part of this amount.

A minor shall consist of a minimum of 18 SCH in a subject closely related to the major. In English, the required freshman courses may not count as part of this amount. At least 50% of the work offered in the major field must be advanced, and at least 6 SCH of advanced work must be offered in the minor field.
