

## Spring 1999 Graduation Profile

### Points of Interest

- ❖ The Spring graduating class of 1999 consisted of 389 graduates: 283 were bachelors, 103 were masters, and 3 were doctorates.
- ❖ Of the 389 graduates, 345 were from Texas, 13 were from other states, and 31 were from other countries when they entered the University.
- ❖ The most frequent county of origin of graduates was Nueces (70) followed by Kleberg (51), Jim Wells (34), Bexar (34), and Cameron (26).
- ❖ Of the graduating class, two hundred and fifty (64.27%) were minority students. One hundred and ninety-eight (69.97%) of the bachelors, fifty (48.55%) of the masters, and two (66.67%) of the doctorates were minority students.
- ❖ Of the graduating class, 197 (50.64%) were female. One hundred and thirty-eight (48.76%) of the bachelors, fifty-seven (55.34%) of the masters, and two (66.67%) of the doctorates were female.
- ❖ Of the 283 bachelors graduates, 145(51.24%) entered the University as first time freshmen and 138 (48.76%) entered as transfer students. Of the 145 first time freshmen, 77 (53.10%) took at least one remediation course.
- ❖ Average age of bachelors was 27.4 years (min 20.7, max 61.8)
- ❖ Average age of masters was 31.7 years (min 21.9, max 50.3)
- ❖ Average age of doctorates was 37.0 years (min 33.0, max 42.3)
