Statement of legal authority as to the tax-exempt status of Texas A&M University-Kingsville (TAMUK).

TAMUK is a general academic teaching institution of the State of Texas. Education Code s.61.003(3).

The Texas A&M University System (TAMUS) is an "other agency" of higher education. Education Code s.61.003 (6).

TAMUK is a component of TAMUS. Education Code s.87.301.

TAMUS and its component educational institutions and agencies are governmental units of the State of Texas. Prairie View A&M University v. Mitchell, 27 S.W.3d 323, 325 (Tex. App.-Hou (1st Dist) 2000, denied).

The Texas A&M University System and its component institutions and agencies are tax exempt under section 115 of the Internal Revenue Code. Contributions to such organizations are deductible by donors as provided in section 170 of the Internal Revenue Code.
