

**FALL 2018 GRADUATION PROFILE  
TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY – KINGSVILLE**

- ❖ The FALL graduating class of 2018 at TAMUK consisted of 585 graduates. Three of them received two bachelor’s degrees. This makes a total of 588 degrees. Out of 588 degrees granted, there are 336 bachelor’s degrees, 247 master’s degrees, and 5 doctoral degrees.
- ❖ Of the 585 graduates, 424 (72%) were from Texas and 12 (2%) were from other states, including Florida (2), Alaska (1), Arizona (1), California (1), Georgia (1), Iowa (1), Maryland (1), Massachusetts (1), New Mexico (1), New York (1) and Virginia (1) when they first entered TAMUK. 149 (25%) were from other countries or regions when they entered the university, including India (125), Nigeria (6), Saudi Arabia (6), Bangladesh (2), Kuwait (2), Mexico (2), Barbados (1), Germany (1), Iran (1), Kenya (1), Nepal (1) and Niger (1).
- ❖ The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Hidalgo (80), followed by Nueces (53), Kleberg (44), Cameron (38) and Jim Wells (31).
- ❖ Of the graduating class, 359 (61%) were minority students. 270 (81%) of the bachelor’s, 87 (35%) of the master’s and 2 (40%) of the doctoral degree recipients were minority students.
- ❖ Of the graduating class, 277 (47%) were female. 178 (53%) of the bachelor’s, 96 (39%) of the master’s and 3 (60%) of doctoral were female.
- ❖ Of the 333 undergraduates, 199 (60%) entered the University as first-time-in-college and 134 (40%) entered as transfer students. Of the 199 first-time-in-college, 52 (26%) took at least one developmental course. 3 (2%) of the 134 transfer students took at least one developmental course.
- ❖ Of the 585 graduates, four were full-time university employees. Two of them received a master’s degree each, one received a bachelor’s and the other was awarded a doctoral degree.
