## FALL 2022 GRADUATION PROFILE TEXAS A\&M UNIVERSITY - KINGSVILLE

* The FALL graduating class of 2022 at TAMUK consisted of 469 graduates. Five of them received two bachelor's degrees each. This makes a total of 474 degrees. Out of 474 degrees granted, there are 290 (61\%) bachelor's degrees, 146 (37\%) master's degrees, and 10 (2\%) doctoral degrees.
* Of the 469 graduates, 381 (81\%) were from Texas and 17 (4\%) were from other states, including California (3), New York (2), Arizona (1), Florida (1), Georgia (1), Illinois (1), Louisiana (1), Minnesota (1), Ohio (1), Pennsylvania (1), Puerto Rico (1), West Virginia (1) and Wisconsin (1) when they first entered TAMUK. 71 (15\%) were from other countries or regions when they entered the university, including India (45), Nigeria (12), Kuwait (4), Bangladesh (2), China (2), Mexico (2), Egypt (1), Ghana (1), Jordan (1) and Vietnam (1).
* The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Nueces (63), followed by Cameron (53), Kleberg (43), Hidalgo (41), and Jim Wells (26).
* Of the graduating class, 325 ( $69 \%$ ) were minority students. 234 ( $82 \%$ ) of the bachelor's, 88 ( $51 \%$ ) of the master's and 3 ( $30 \%$ ) of the doctoral degree recipients were minority students.
* Of the graduating class, 257 (55\%) were female. 166 (58\%) of the bachelor's, 86 ( $49 \%$ ) of the master's and 5 ( $50 \%$ ) of doctoral were female.
* Of the 285 undergraduates, 155 (54\%) entered the University as first-time-in-college and 130 (46\%) entered as transfer students. Of the 155 first-time-in-college, 38 (25\%) took at least one developmental course. 7 (5\%) of the 113 transfer students took at least one developmental course.
* Of the 469 graduates, six were full-time university employees, including one bachelor's degree recipient, four who received master's degrees and the other one earning a doctoral degree.
