

## **SPRING 2017 GRADUATION PROFILE TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY–KINGSVILLE**

- ❖ The SPRING graduating class of 2017 at Texas A&M University-Kingsville consisted of 1046 graduates. Five of them received two bachelor's degrees. This makes a total of 1051 degrees for SPRING 2017. Out of 1051 degrees granted, there were 594 bachelor's degrees, 447 master's degrees, and 10 doctoral degrees.
- ❖ For Spring 2017, Texas A&M University-Kingsville graduated the largest class ever in university history. The second largest class occurred in Spring 2016 when a total of 1020 degrees were granted, including 558 bachelor's, 442 master's, and 20 doctoral degrees
- ❖ Of the 1046 graduates, 661 (63%) were from Texas, 17 (2%) were from other states when they entered the university, including California (5), Georgia (1), Hawaii (1), Illinois (1), Indiana (1), Louisiana (1), Massachusetts (1), Nebraska (1), New Mexico (1), New York (1), Pennsylvania (1), Tennessee (1), and Virginia (1). 368 (35%) were from other countries or regions, including India (341), Saudi Arabia (8), Nigeria (5), Kuwait (4), Mexico (2), South Korea (2), Australia (1), Canada (1), China (1), Colombia (1), Ecuador (2), Iran (1), and Nepal (1).
- ❖ The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Hidalgo (138), followed by Nueces (94), Cameron (62), Kleberg (57) and Bexar (30).
- ❖ Of the graduating class, 513 (49%) were minority students. 434 (74%) of the bachelor's, 72 (16%) of the master's, and 7 (70%) of the doctoral graduates were minority students.
- ❖ Of the graduating class, 435 (42%) were female. 281 (48%) of the bachelor's, 146 (33%) of the master's, and 8 (80%) of the doctoral graduates were female.
- ❖ Of the 589 undergraduates, 313 (53%) entered the university as first-time undergraduates and 276 (47%) entered as transfer students. Of the 313 first-time undergraduates, 80 (26%) took at least one developmental course. Of the 276 transfer students, 7 (3%) took at least one developmental course.
