

## **SPRING 2018 GRADUATION PROFILE TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY–KINGSVILLE**

- ❖ The SPRING graduating class of 2018 at Texas A&M University-Kingsville consisted of 949 graduates. Five of them received two bachelor's degrees. This makes a total of 954 degrees for SPRING 2018. Out of 954 degrees granted, there were 556 bachelor's degrees, 385 master's degrees, and 13 doctoral degrees.
- ❖ Of the 949 graduates, 660 (70%) were from Texas, 20 (2%) were from other states when they entered the university, including California (6), Kentucky (2), New York (2), Alabama (1), Alaska (1), Colorado (1), Georgia (1), Illinois (1), Indiana (1), Iowa (1), Louisiana (1), Utah (1), and Virgin Islands (1). 269 (28%) were from other countries or regions, including India (223), Nigeria (12), Kuwait (8), Saudi Arabia (8), Mexico (4), Nepal (2), Venezuela (2), British Virgin Islands (1), Cameroon (1), China (1), Democratic Republic of the Congo (1), Egypt (1), Ghana (1), Iran (1), Norway (1), Spain (1) and United Arab Emirates (1).
- ❖ The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Hidalgo (143), followed by Nueces (77), Cameron (65), Kleberg (61) and Bexar (33).
- ❖ Of the graduating class, 531 (56%) were minority students. 422 (77%) of the bachelor's, 102 (26%) of the master's, and 7 (54%) of the doctoral graduates were minority students.
- ❖ Of the graduating class, 428 (45%) were female. 272 (49%) of the bachelor's, 150 (39%) of the master's, and 6 (46%) of the doctoral graduates were female.
- ❖ Of the 551 undergraduates, 293 (53%) entered the university as first-time undergraduates and 258 (47%) entered as transfer students. Of the 293 first-time undergraduates, 61 (21%) took at least one developmental course. Of the 258 transfer students, 7 (3%) took at least one developmental course.
