You are unable to make changes to your meal plan after the 5th class day of classes, unless you are looking to upgrade which you can do at any time.





LIVING & LEARNING at TAMUK

University Housing & Residence Life



Required Residence Policy

- Any student under 20 years of age or has less than 30 credit hours (does not include dual credit) must reside on campus for one academic year.
- Students will be automatically exempted if living with a parent or guardian commuting within a 50 mile radius of Kingsville.
- All other students wishing to reside off campus must complete a Housing Exception Request Form.
- Enrolled students who do not receive approval for a Housing Exception will be billed for on-campus housing.

The Application Process

- 1. Be accepted to TAMUK
- 2. Submit a copy of your immunization record to Med Proctor showing that you have received the meningitis vaccine. Med Proctor will notify Student Health & Wellness when the vaccination is approved.
- 3. Complete an Academic Year Housing Agreement online in the StarRezPortalX.
- 4. Place \$150 Room Reservation and Damage Deposit.
- 5. Up until July 15 students will self select their housing assignment based off available hall inventory by date of application in the StarRezPortalX. After that time frame students will be assigned by University Housing & Residence Life.

Residence Halls

All rooms come with a Twin Size Bed, Mattress, Desk, Chair and closet per student.

<u>Traditional Community Hall</u> Martin Hall – Male & Female

Community Style Hall provide a sharable room with each hallway sharing the same bathroom area.

Suite Style Hall Lynch Hall – Female

Suite style design provides a sharable room with suitemates connected to the adjoining room sharing a bathroom area.

Suite Style Co-Ed Halls
Lucio Hall
Mesquite Village West
(All Rooms are gender specific)

Suite style come in two-bedroom suite with one bathroom and four-bedroom suite with two bathrooms.

Each suite includes private bedrooms, and a shared living room and kitchenette space.

Residence Hall Amenities



Amenities available include lounges with televisions, courtyards with basketball and volleyball courts (Martin Hall) and BBQ grills, full kitchens, laundry rooms, workout rooms, computer labs, and study rooms.

Internet

All residence hall rooms are equipped with high speed Ethernet connections as well as wireless internet. You provide your own computer, electronics, and cables.



Living & Learning Communities

We offer Living Learning Communities in our residence halls so you can live, study, and develop friendships with students who share your same major. Students are selected through enrollment in their UNIV course and the Honors College to be part of the LLC's. Current LLCs and

Food Services

Real Food on Campus at Javelina Dining Hall. State of the art all-you-care-to-eat residential dining. Enjoy a variety of foods, including fresh deli sandwiches, hot pizza, rotisserie chicken and stir-fry.

Food Court at Student Union Building also available and include Chick-fil-A, Subway, Pizza Hut Express, and Starbucks.

Students are required to choose a meal plan and optional for students who are 21 years or older.


