2022 Student Leadership Recognition Awards

Dear Student Leaders,

The Student Engagement and Campus Life staff recognizes that student organizations and individual student leaders contribute a great deal to the Texas A&M University – Kingsville community. The Student Leadership Recognition Awards Program is our way of formally recognizing you and your organization for your contributions. The reception will be held on **Thursday, April 21, 2021** in **MSUB–RM 221 at 6:00-8:00 p.m.**

Enclosed you will find the application packet for the Leadership Recognition Program 2022. This packet contains all of the information that you will need to become part of this annual event designed to honor outstanding students and student organizations at our Texas A&M University-Kingsville campus.

How to Place a Nomination:

- ◆ A **student** may **self-nominate** him/herself for only **one award, OR** may nominate their organization or another member of the organization for one award per category. Advisors may also nominate students /organizations per category.
- ◆ Each application must consist of the enclosed nomination form as well as any supporting documents the award may require.
- ◆ Any student nominated for any of the individual awards must be currently enrolled at Texas A&M University – Kingsville.
- ◆ A nominated person or student organization may invite no more than five guests. Must make reservations with the Javelina Student Engagement Center by **Friday, April 8th, 2022**.
- ◆ When nominating a student or organization, fill out the enclosed nomination form and give it to the nominee for required signature. Self-nominations require advisor signature. Then return the completed application to the Javelina Student Engagement Center.

In describing activities, programs or events in the nomination criteria, the year will be defined as March 1st, 2021 through February 28th, 2022. Individual Leadership Awards

1. Outstanding Student Organization Member Award

Awarded to a student who has exhibited the highest standards of involvement but has not held a leadership position in a recognized student organization. This individual must demonstrate excellent leadership potential, commitment of time and energy to the organization, and positive impact on the achievement of organizational goals and the University community. The recipient will be awarded a \$250 scholarship.

2. Outstanding Individual Leader Award

Awarded to a student who demonstrates the highest level of outstanding leadership by serving as a positive role model, practicing ethical behavior, honoring commitment, and displaying responsibility. The recipient will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship. We are

3. Outstanding Greek Man/Woman Award

Awarded to a male and female student, currently a member of a recognized Greek organization, who has displayed the ability to be an excellent ambassador of the TAMUK Fraternity & Sorority Life, and has made a strong and lasting impression on their chapter and TAMUK's Fraternity & Sorority Life as a whole. The recipient will be awarded a \$500 scholarship.

4. Emerging Leader Scholarship

Awarded to a student who has not yet held a leadership role in a student organization but will be serving in a significant leadership position in the coming year. The recipient will be awarded a \$200 scholarship for leadership development and a \$250 scholarship.

5. Outstanding Student Organization Advisor

Awarded to the faculty/staff member that best demonstrates an outstanding level of commitment to leadership and to the members and goals of the organization.

Event/Program Awards

1. Student Government Association Outstanding Community Service Project or Program

- a. Awarded to a student organization responsible for conducting an outstanding community service event on or off campus. This program, project, or event may provide service to the University community and/or Kingsville community. The recipient will be awarded a \$250 scholarship.

2. Excellence in Diversity Programming

- a. Awarded to a student organization that has displayed exceptional educational awareness of cultural diversity through innovative programming that reflects the ever-changing demographics of our global society.

3. Outstanding Collaborative Effort

- a. Awarded to student organizations that have demonstrated a commitment and effort toward working effectively with other students/organizations and have been successful in planning a collaborative event.

4. Campus Activities Board Program of the Year

- a. Awarded to a student organization for an outstanding social education or awareness program. Programs for consideration must have occurred between March 1, 2021 and February 28, 2022. The recipient will be awarded a \$250 scholarship.

5. Impact Award

- a. Awarded to a student or student organization demonstrating a commitment to positive social change more than once a year. This student or organization identified a problem, challenged injustice or inequality (on or off campus) and implemented a plan to make a difference in solving or addressing this need or concern.

Organization Awards

1. Outstanding Greek Chapter Award (Organization Award)

a. Awarded to an officially recognized fraternity or sorority in good standing under the jurisdiction of a Greek Council that has demonstrated a commitment toward improving the quality of life at Texas A&M University-Kingsville through its events, programs, or services.

b. Selection Criteria:

- 1) Demonstrate the chapter's commitment to responding to the needs of students and the needs of the TAMUK community as a whole
- 2) Detail any events, programs, or services that the chapter has sponsored or co-sponsored which have improved the quality of life (intellectual, social, recreational, cultural) at TAMUK
- 3) Demonstrate the chapter's commitment to providing programs that promote interaction among the many different subcultures, both Greek and non-Greek, of the TAMUK community
- 4) Describe the chapter's commitment to excellence in the fulfillment of its purpose and goals in terms of membership, academics, and service
- 5) Provide an official membership list of the chapter

2. Order of Omega Outstanding Academic Achievement

a. Awarded to a student organization demonstrating an understanding of the importance of balancing academic achievement and co-curricular involvement. This group must demonstrate that the mission of the organization can be accomplished without negatively impacting the academic success of its members. The recipient will be awarded a \$250 scholarship.

3. Student Government Association Outstanding Student Organization

a. Awarded to an outstanding student organization which has demonstrated a commitment to excellence by improving the quality of life at Texas A&M University – Kingsville through its events, programs, or services. The recipient will be awarded a \$200 scholarship.
