

- 5. Keep the current start date and remove labor day holiday with two days on online instruction (one T/TH class and one MWF class).

College Station moved their start date to August 19th Wednesday to accommodate the three days lost after Thanksgiving. Finals are online.

Commerce has stated they will not return after Thanksgiving. Their calendar has not changed so I assume they will provide online instruction and online finals after Thanksgiving.

Corpus has not indicated they will change on their calendar.
