Lesson Focus and Goals

SUBJECT OBJECTIVE:

1. Learn about Anne Frank and get to experience living like her during her period of hiding as a Jew during the Holocaust

JHSL OBJECTIVE:

- 1. Work with student to experience an example of how Jewish citizens lived in hiding during the Holocaust.
- 2. Expose students to the reality of what the Holocaust did to Jewish folks.

Structure/Activity

1. Halliburton Introduction Talk (approx. 5 minutes, only if not have been completed before with students)

This workshop is made available by the Javelina Halliburton STEM Labs (JHSlabs for short). Even though Halliburton is an oil and gas industry, Halliburton is also very invested in the next generation STEM Workforce. The JHS Labs provide the opportunities to enhance high level critical thinking and problem-solving skills associated with sciences, technology, engineering, math, and geosciences (STEM) to talented, underserved high school and undergraduate students. Halliburton provides meaningful engagement and resources for students that want to explore the engineering field.

2. Level 1 (approx. 1-2 minutes)

A narrator introduces the story of Anne Frank and what led to have her, her family and some friends to go into hiding. We are let to know the period of hiding took two years.

3. **Level 2** (approx. 20-30 minutes)

Students will be guided through Anne Frank's hiding space in a storytelling manner. They will be guided to touch, move, and look around to proceed with the story telling experience.

4. Level 3 - Conclusion (approx. 2-3 minutes)

Foreboding music starts. The narrator will conclude and let us know how Anne Frank's story was given a chance to be told. Anne Frank still lives on in her story
