## Your Responsibilities as a Student

- ♦ Schedule an appointment to meet with your advisor (at least once per semester)
  - Before you register for classes each semester
  - Before adding, dropping, or withdrawing from classes
  - Whenever you experience academic difficulty (scholastic probation, doing poorly in a class, etc.)
- ♦ Know the degree requirements of TAMU-Kingsville and your major (found in the student guide.)
- ♦ Be familiar with the academic calendar for information such as Add/Drop, Qdrop, and withdrawal deadlines, registration dates, and final exam schedule.
- ♦ Give accurate information to your advisor about study habits, interest, abilities, etc.
- ♦ Prepare a list of questions to ask your advisor.
- ♦ Take an active role in the advising process
- ♦ Register for classes as soon as possible
- ♦ Maintain your own personal academic records.
